Engagement Summary Integrated Transport Strategy



What were we engaging	Significant consultation took place through 2021, where we asked
on?	our community how we can create well planned and people friendly
	transport environments.
	Based on this, we then developed PAE's first Integrated Transport Strategy (ITS). This final engagement took place to hear feedback on the draft ITS and make any last changes as suggested.
What did we do?	Council's Have Your Say (HYS) Platform was used to engage with the community on the draft Integrated Transport Strategy. The HYS page was advertised across the Council website and social media platforms, along with first round contributors being sent a notification of the draft ITS for review. The HYS page also included a copy of the social map from first round contributors so members of the public could easily see the original feedback that had been used to develop the plan.
	The final engagement was focused on the Draft ITS to understand from the community the following: • That the transport issues and ideas from the first round of feedback has been accurately captured • That the six key themes were correct and appropriate • That the strategic directions were correct and appropriate • Any other feedback.
	The HYS final engagement stage received 379 visits and 5 contributions. This is typical of a detailed strategic document where there is significant community feedback at the inception stage, which decreases as you converge on the final output.
What did we hear?	A summary of the feedback received was:
	 The six key transport themes were supported Active transport (public transport, walking and cycling) was a key area of comment with suggestions provided on how to best deliver the strategic directions The importance that sea/rail freight plays in the transport network Review of 40km/hr speed zones.
	Feedback received was positive and supportive of the ITS and strategic directions. Some minor updates have been made to capture this feedback. Other feedback received related to specific considerations / locations when implementing the various studies and upgrades within the ITS.
What are the next steps?	The ITS was endorsed at the 8 March 2022 Full Council Meeting. No further steps remain for this consultation.
